

CROSS OUT CANCER MISSION & VISION

Cross Out Cancer, Inc. was established with the intention of uniting high school cross country runners from competing teams in an effort to raise money for families in financial need with a child suffering from cancer. Comprised of representatives from eleven high schools around Tampa Bay, Cross Out Cancer hosts an annual 5K run/walk and partners with local business to benefit a restricted fund at Johns Hopkins All Children's Hospital, the funds from which solely benefit families struggling financially with a child undergoing treatment for cancer. Cross Out Cancer aims to establish a new generation of community leaders dedicated to service, act as a catalyst for unity among the running community, and raise awareness about the unique struggle that pediatric cancer patients and their families face. By 2020, Cross Out Cancer aims to have raised over \$250,000 and affect over 200 families at Johns Hopkins All Children's Hospital.
